

The Nobel Museum illustrates a century of creativity. Follow the changes of the 20th century through the Nobel Prize and the Laureates. Explore the work and the ideas of more than 700 creative minds presented through short films, original artifacts and computers, in the exhibition "Cultures of Creativity." See the dynamite, the mould and the books that changed the world! Visit the Nobel Museum in the heart of Stockholm, the Old Town/Gamla Stan. The Nobel Museum also has an inspiring book and giftshop well worth a visit.

The museum shop offers an extensive yet selective range of literature. Subjects cover the Nobel Prize and prize areas, the life and times of Alfred Nobel, the prize awarding institutions, and of course books written by and about Nobel Laureates. The prize-winning exhibition catalogue "Cultures of Creativity" is also for sale in no fewer than four languages.

A selection of children's books, activity sets, experimental kits and learning toys is also available. Visitors will also find postcards, posters and selected pieces of the famous Nobel dinner service.
